Dole Again Rips Watergate Probe Of Ford's Records

Moline, Ill.

GOP vice presidential candidate Robert Dole said again yesterday that the Watergate special prosecutor's investigation of President Ford's previous congressional campaigns is unfair.

Dole, who has testified before a grand jury about alleged Gulf Oil Co. payments to his own 1974 senatorial campaign, was asked what effect special prosecutor Charles Ruff's probe into Mr. Ford's financial records would have on the current campaign.

"I don't know — it's all one-sided. But we expect that," he said at a news conference. Asked to elaborate, Dole said, "I don't see him (Ruff) looking any other place."
