Carter Won't

Jimmy Carter said yesterday he accepts findings of the special prosecutor that President Ford did not violate the law in the use of his campaign funds.

"I have no reason to dispute those conclusions," Carter said when he was told of the report.

But he said he will not apologize for his earlier statements demanding that Mr. Ford "tell the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth about his personal finances."

"I never used his violating or not violating the law as a campaign issue," Carter said. "I just said he ought to hold a press conference to explain these things rather than hide in the White House."
