

Greece to Consider

A Move to Keep

Agnew Out

Athens

A bill to declare former vice president Spiro Agnew an undesirable alien in Greece was submitted to parliament yesterday by opposition Deputy Constantine Komiotakis.

The deputy from Crete said that Agnew had encouraged the military junta in Greece and is now involved with "colonialist capitalists trying to exploit the toil of the Greek people."

Parliamentary sources said it was unlikely that parliament would pass such a law.

Agnew was given a hero's welcome when he visited Greece as vice president in 1972 when the Greek military dictatorship was in power.
