

Bagman Ulasewicz Creamed

Watergate bagman Anthony Ulasewicz was hit in the side of the head with a pie yesterday as he was leaving federal court.

The deed was claimed by Aron Kay, a Youth International party member (Yippie) who also claims to have smacked Senator-elect Daniel Moynihan and Senator James L. Buckley with pies during their New York campaign.

"It was a coconut cream pie," Kay said after making his escape from a corridor in U.S. District court in Brooklyn, where Ulasewicz is on trial for tax evasion. "It cost \$1.50. Sometimes I use lemon meringue."

Kay said he threw the pie "because the Yippies oppose the crimes that were committed against the people . . . by the Nixon and Ford administrations."

He said the attack with the pie was "a prelude to a counter-inaugural demonstration in Washington on January 20" when President-elect Jimmy Carter is to be sworn into office.

Ulasewicz was hit during a recess in his trial, where former Nixon men John Ehrlichman, John Dean and Herbert Kalmbach testified yesterday for the prosecution.

Ulasewicz, a 57-year-old former New York cop who supplied the comic relief at the Senate Water-

gate committee when he told his adventures in distributing \$200,000 in hush money to Watergate con-

spirators, is charged with two counts of filing a false and fraudulent tax return.

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
