The clips on Hoover and the FBI are of interest to me. Somewhere I have many files I began collecting on him in the 30s. Anything is of potential value in my current work, but for years I have regarded him as a dedicated fascist who mistakes his beliefs, with utmost seriousness, as the essente of true patriotism. He is genuine about it. It is not put on. I guess one could say the same for Hitler. All this business about retaliation against employees for what is none of his business is not new, either. It also goes back to not later than more than 30 years ago. I once knew a couple of the then victims. His agents feared it and told me frankly that they had to peach on each other, for failure to do so could lead to retaliation is any one did and the others didn't...The McCabe column seems unlike what I'd expect in that paper. Perhaps it represents a beginning of a change outside Washington. HW
