JDW: your note of 1/6/74 attached to SFEram 1/6 on Barker says as much as can be, that it is "interesting" that the 1774 Hunt each suffered an affliction while jailed. One can t say more because these things do happen. I knew this was Bell's palsey because identically the same thing had happened to a friend and not in bitterest cold. (Thereafter they remain subject to recurrences from cold, tho.) Hunt is the type who I would assume is more susceptible to a stroke and I am willing to assume that those who understand these things may have helped induce it. But there really is no way of knowing. I think is alsi an "interesting" coincidence that things stopped happening to unt at a certain point and that thereafter he displayed all signs of living up to an engoing deal/... n the sentences I think all except Liddy's are very light under the circumstances and given the truly subversive character of the crimes, the number of charges, etc. Remember my earliest comment on Sirica?

Today a nice girl in my Senator's office sent me Ervin 9. Rather it came today. Includes thru Hunt, 2 9/25. Wen't mind a bit now if til is delayed leaving her office!

Sent Russell piece, which she retyped, to London agent this a.m. I'm too close and too involved to be able to decide whether it is adequate. But I think that any attention to the contents at this point might do some good. Best IW 1/11/74
