

McCord^{*} statement, NYTimes 3/2/74: First time I've seen any of these. JL is supposed to provide all but has not. No recollection reporting ~~h~~ his charge of silence against prosecutors, which seems to be proper. He also seems to say that the 3/21 meeting was the day after Sirica read McCord's letter. Recall my earlier references to 3/19? I believe that is the day McCord wrote it or gave it to his parole officer. Or, assuming GL had had no earlier knowledge, which I do not, this meant there could be no more delay in telling him. Or he might be reading in the papers what he did not know. Or some feared their heads would roll. The timing with relationship to the McCord letter seems to have been pretty well ignored. HW 3/25/74
