More reported yesterday, more today and we're sort of boxed in since he only gets mad, doesn't stop. I go into this in the event you know anyone out there who follows the underground press. They alone are giving him attention and it is extensive. Don't go subscribing to anything now. I wish I had been able to follow all this stupidity from the first. Might have seen a pattern that might explain. Jim and I think that the most likely explanation is that it is all going to his head and that he plans to run for office...Today's Post's O'Brien story is not at all like the version I heard a little before 5 a.m. on the CBS NYC station. In that version he said, explicitly, that if EMK runs he'll be assassinated...Think I sent an unready uncorrected draft of a proposed affidavit for us to file in opposition to Frank's effort to avoid complying with the discovery order.
