As I recall what Rod then told us it is that "ris wound up personna non grata in the USSR. What he actually did there required daring, imagination and some initiative. Or, a competent journalist, one of the few able to get the USSR to do what it does not do.

I also know from personal experience that the Enquirer checks its UFO \*\*EXTEXT\*\* stories with care. I sold them a lead on a pair of local sightings. It had a switch that CBers did the sightings and were in touch with each other on them.

I would imagine that of all the press they would have best files, notes, etc. on this subject. Look forward to read the piece.

Too bad Pope, who is the dictator there, hasn't seen fit to take the next step, to become more responsible. He is building circulation too fast to risk what he fears it would do. I'm sure he's wrong, merely his own prisoner within the mind.
