OAU Seats Angola

Addis Ababa

An Angolan delegation took its place for the first time yesterday at a meeting of the Organization of African Unity.

Other delegates applauded when the Angolans, representing the People's Republic formed by the Popular Movement (MPLA), entered the conference room.

In a speech opening the six-day conference, Ethiopian head of state Teferi Bante recalled that the world had interpreted the inconclusive adjournment of the OAU meeting six weeks ago as a failure and had said Africa was irreparably divided.

He said that a solution of the Angolan dispute has now been found.
