Nixon Talks To Rocky About Riot

President Nixon yesterday telephoned New York governor Nelson Rockefeller to express support for the way authorities handled the prison riot at Attica.

White House spokesman Gerald Warren indicated Mr. Nixon expressed his support of the decision to refuse amnesty to the leaders of the riot and to send in National Guardsmen and police to battle the inmates.

Mr. Nixon telephoned Rockefeller after the governor called the White House with details of the bloody battle.
