San Quentin's Message To Attica

Attica, N.Y.

The telegram taped to a wall at the front entrance to Attica prison read:

"Our hearts are with you. Our motto is 'We have just begun to fight.'"

The telegram was sent on the first day of the riot to guards at Attica from corrections officers at San Quentin prison, where an escape attempt last month took six lives.
