

### Podell Urges Rockefeller To Call a Special Session

Representative Bertram L. Podell, Brooklyn Democrat, sent a telegram to Governor Rockefeller yesterday urging the appointment of a Moreland Act commissioner and calling for a special session of the Legislature to make changes in its penal system, which he said "for many years has operated in bankruptcy."

The telegram read, in part:

"Justice demands the immediate appointment of a Moreland Act Commissioner to conduct a complete investigation into the deaths at Attica prison."

The Moreland Act authorizes the setting up of special inquiries.

### Workers With Truck Sweep Up the Debris

Workers with a green truck swept up the litter today on the grounds of the State Correctional Facility.

In the debris were hundreds of broken plastic coffee cups, empty beer and soda bottles, strips of film, scraps of yellow legal pads, pieces of old newspapers, dozens of doughnut cartons, hundreds of breadsticks and empty boxes marked "Medical Supplies for Hospitals—For Use Only After an Enemy Attack."
