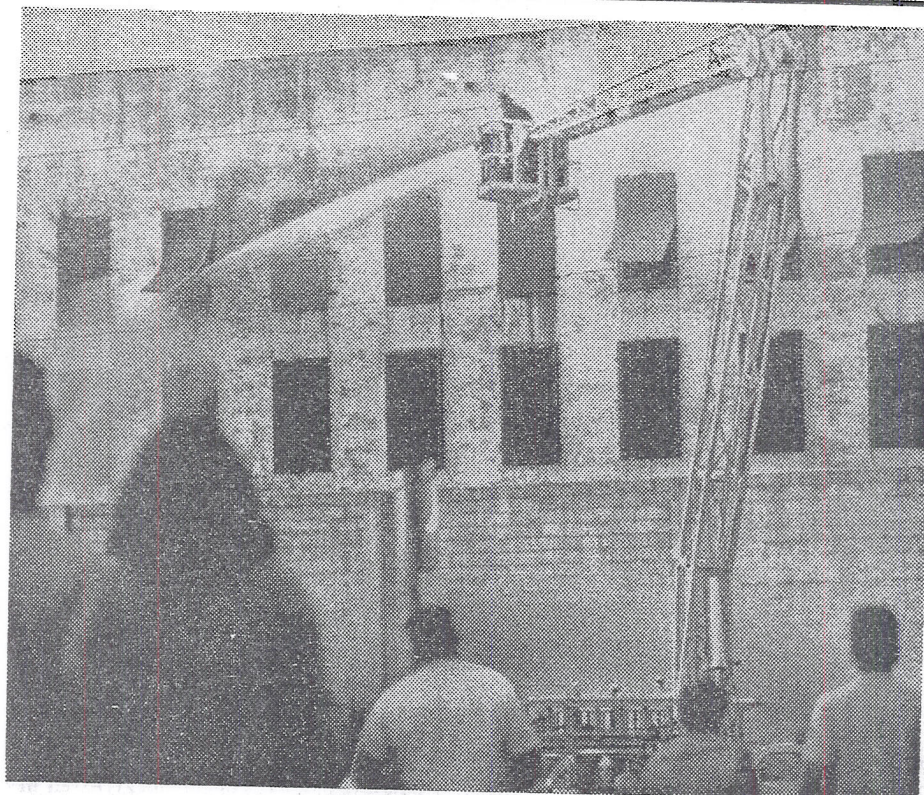

Rioting Cons Give Up

New Orleans, La.

Fifty - four prisoners who had barricaded themselves in the Orleans Parish Prison during a five - hour disturbance Monday night surrendered without resistance after noon yesterday, officials

said.

The 54 were the last of a group of more than 250 inmates who caused severe damage to the three - story structure during the incident.

The warden said 267 of the 935 inmates in the 42-year -

old prison had participated in the disturbance.

There were no reports of injuries. Inmates broke windows, tore doors off hinges and set fire to mattresses, security officer Bert Barrere said.
