

Teacher Denies Bomb Plot; Says Idea Was Discussed

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 19 (UPI) — William Davidon, a professor at suburban Haverford College, denied today any part of an alleged kidnapping-bombing plot reported by the Federal Government last week but acknowledged that such ideas had been discussed.

Asked at a news conference if he had discussed with others the alleged plan to kidnap Henry A. Kissinger, Presidential assistant, and the bombing of Government buildings, Professor Davidon replied, "Yes."

He said, "We explore ideas and want to continue to be able to continue to explore ideas." But, he added, the group did not discuss "in any serious way the kidnapping of a Government official." Professor Davidon, who does work for the local Quaker action group, said he would not "do anything that threatens human life."

The physics professor, who is 43 years old, said he knew many of the persons indicted or named as co-conspirators and that the charges were false.
