## Nun Is Told to Face Contempt Charges After Jury Silence

A Roman Catholic nun has been ordered to answer Gov-ernment charges of contempt in Brooklyn Federal Court this morning. She had refused to testify yesterday before a grand jury that is believed to be linked in some way with the case of the Rev. Philip F. Berrigan and others awaiting trial in Harrisburg, Pa.

Sister Carol Vericker, years old was one of six women subpoenaed to testify yesterday and the first to appear before the closed hearing.

Government lawyers asked today's hearing had been scheduled, Sister Carol said she had against each other.

Federal Judge Anthony J. Travia to cite her for contempt and order her to jail for the duration of the jury session after she declined to answer questions despite a grant of immunity by the judge.
