## Colby Text as Published Contained Erroneous 'Not'

Contained Erroneous 'Not' In some editions of The New York Times yesterday, para-graph in the text of a report by William E. Colby, Director of Central Intelligence, to a Senate Appropriations subcom-mittee contained an erroneous "not" that distorted the mean-ing of his statement. The paragraph, in its correct form, read: "In this context, it is clear that C.I.A. does have material on large numbers of Americans, as applicants, current and ex-employes, sources and other contracts, contractors, govern-ment and contractor personnel cleared for access to sensitive categories of intelligence, ref-erences and other names aris-ing during security investiva-tions, individuals corresponding with us, etc." The word "not" appeared er-roneously near the beginning of the sentence between "does" and "have."
