## CIA Probers Meet With Colson

Washington .

Investigators for the Rockeieller commission met priyately with former White
House special counsel
Charles W. Colson yesterday
to probe allegations he has
made concerning CIA domestic operations.

Neither Colson nor his atterney Kenneth L. Adams was available for commet and a spokesman for the commission refused to knowledge that the meetin had taken place.

However two administration oficials confirmed that Cuson had met with "several members of the staff for a couple of hours."

Colson, who was released from prison less than two weeks ago after serving seven months of a one-to-three-tear ferm for obstruction of justice, has made a number of accusations concerning the CIA.

In a recent television interview. Colson said it was inconceivable to him that the agency would not have seen aware of plans for break us at both Democratic headquarters in the Watergate complex and the offices of Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist.

Earlier, Colson had told Senators Lowell P Weicker (Nep-Coun.) and Howard H. Baker Jr. (Rep-Tenn.) that convicted Watergate conspirator E. Howard Hunt forwarded sealed packages to then - CIA director Richard M. Heims up until a month before the June 1972 Watergate break-in
