## Joint Push on Intelligence Units' Reform

Washington

In an unusual move, the Senate select committee on intelligence is cooperating with the White House on proposals to reform and control the intelligence community, Senate and White House officials disclosed yesterday.

The officials said the executive and legislative cooperation began in mid-December when the Senate investigating committee turned to the problem of legislative overseeing of the Central Intelligence Agency and other intelligence agencies.

So far, the House select committee has not participated in the work on possible joint legislative proposals, House sources said.

These disclosures followed a meeting of top-level intelligence experts and agency heads at the White House Saturday. The meeting was called by President Ford to begin mapping out legislative proposals for reform of the intelligence community.
