

# CIA Agents' List Printed in Paris

## Paris

The extreme left-wing newspaper Liberation published today what it said are the names of 32 agents of the Central Intelligence Agency attached to the U.S. embassy here.

Liberation said it identified the alleged agents by cross-checking several different staff registers published by the U.S. State Department, including the Paris embassy's internal telephone directory.

The newspaper published the home addresses and telephone numbers of eight of the 32 people named, saying these are the most important members of the CIA establishment here. All names

were accompanied by the person's embassy office number and internal telephone extension.

Two of those named appear in the French Foreign Ministry's diplomatic list: Eugen Burgstaller and John Berg, both listed as U.S. embassy attaches. Liberation named Burgstaller as the station chief and carried two photographs of him on the front page.

The identification of CIA agents angered CIA officials in Washington last month after its chief officer in Greece, Richard Welch, was assassinated, and it was revealed that a Washington publication had identified him as a CIA agent before he was slain.
