Senators Daniel Inouye of Hawaii and Clifford Case of New Jersey were named yesterday as the senior Democratic and Republican members of the newly created Senate committee to monitor U.S. intelligence activities.

Democrats in addition to Inouye are Birch Bayh of Indiana, Adlai Stevenson of Illinois, Walter Huddleston of Kentucky, Joseph Biden of Delaware, Gary Hart of Colorado, Robert Morgan of North Carolina and William Hathaway of Maine.

The Republicans in addition to Case are Mark Hatfield of Oregon, Barry Goldwater of Arizona, Strom Thurmond of South Carolina, Howard Baker of Tennessee, Robert Stafford of Vermont and Jake Garn of Utah.
