"The CIA," said attorney Henry B. Rothblatt, "distorted information to precipitate the hearing. Then, on cross examination, a representative of the agency was caught in lies and hid behind executive privilege."

Rothblatt returned yesterday from Saigon and said he is confident the Army will drop charges against the eight Special Forces members "within a week."

No Proof

"They just don't have any evidence," he said of the Army.

Rothblatt said he could not discuss details of the case because they were classified by the military.

He said, however, the case was fouled up by "incompetents on one level advising incompetents on a higher level.'

The Vietnamese the Berest are accused of killing last June 20 was reportedly working for both the CIA and the North Vietnamese.
