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Berets in Vietnam Still Resentful and Suspicious

According to Sergeant Clements, a hard-bitten drawling noncom from Midwest City, Okla., Eichmann's role in mass execution of Jews was "inhuman and ruthless—but he had his orders."

Most of those questioned believed that the Army was motivated by resentment of the "élite status" of the Green Berets. The animosity of the Special Forces men questioned focuses on Gen. Creighton W. Abrams, commander of American forces in Victory Abrams, commander of American forces in Vietnam.
