U.S. and North Korea Meet 9th Time on Pueblo Crew

WASHINGTON, Feb. 26 (AP) —Representatives of the United States and North Korea met for the ninth time at Panmun-jom today to discuss the Ameri-can demand for the release of the intelligence ship Pueblo and her 82 surviving crew members. A State Department spokes-man, asked to describe any progress in the negotiations, said he would "have to leave it at no sign of movement" and that he would not want to raise unjustified hope. Secretary of State Dean Rusk said only that efforts to arrange the release of the men were continuing.
