

Dutch Crew to Sail Ship Ordered by No. Korea

ROTTERDAM, the Netherlands, Nov. 26 (AP)—A fish-processing ship under construction here for North Korea will sail in January under the Dutch flag and with a Dutch crew, a spokesman for Verolmes United Shipbuilding Yards said today.

The spokesman commented on a Washington dispatch, published today in The New York Times, that said American agents had been seeking to create the impression that the ship, and a sister ship also being built for North Korea, might be seized to force the North Koreans to free the 82 crewmen of the United States intelligence ship Pueblo.

The spokesman declared that the 7,050-ton Kuemgang San would be a Dutch ship until she reached North Korea to be transferred to the Korea Equipment Import Corporation.
