OKLAHOMA CITY, May 27 (UPI)—World Neighbors, Inc., an international helping-hand organization, disclosed Saturday that several years ago it rejected a Central Intelligence Agency offer of funds "for a price." Dr. John L. Peters, organizer and president of the group, said, "We decided to reject the funds offered." Ralph Sanders, public relations director, said the C.I.A. offer was presented several years ago and the amount of money was not clearly stated before World Neighbors declined the aid.
