He also accused the Nixon administration of going out of its way to offend the Allende goverment, first, by retaining the ambassador who is now a persona non grata and, secondly, by cancelling a courtesy visit by the U.S. aircraft carrier Enterprise to Valparaiso in February.

The stop, he noted, was to have been made at Allende's personal invitation and Nixon is directly credited with calling off the goodwill ceremony.
