

The Junta Frees Four Yanks

Chile's junta government yesterday released four imprisoned Americans, including two graduate students held on subversion charges and plans soon to release two detained Maryknoll missionaries, the U.S. embassy reported.

Released were Adam and

Patricia Schesch, in Chile working for a University of Wisconsin land tenure program, and John Ceretti, 22, and Henry Warlow, 22, occupations and hometowns unknown. All had been held in the national stadium along with several thousand other persons being investigated for alleged subversion.

The embassy said that the government had asked the Scheschs to leave the country promptly and said they would depart today.

Release of Catholic missionaries Brother Joseph Dougherty, 29, and seminarian Francis Flynn, 27, is "imminent," the embassy said.
