Mrs. Allende Charges Link Of CIA, ITT

Mexico City

"The Strange marriage" of International Telephone and Telegraph Corp. and the Central Intelligence Agency was blamed yesterday for the overthrow of Chile's Marxist government.

Hortensia Allende, widow of the deposed Chilean president, appealed to the 400 delegates to the 14th annual United Press conference of editors and publishers to help end the "unfair and cruel punishment that my countrymen are suffering today.

"From the very moment that the ballots registered the triumph of Unidad Popular (Allende's coalition party), multinational corporations, directed by the strange marriage of ITT and CIA, attempted to overthrow the victorious people," she said.

"And we all know that this policy of shameless interference tolerated by the North American government, had already been rehearsed successfully in Santo Domingo, Guatemala, Brazil and Bolivia, but defeated at the Bay of Pigs."

Both ITT and the CIA have denied any role in the overthrow of the Allende government.
