WXPost DEC 2 2 1973 2d Jail Term Is Given Fla. Reporter

DADE CITY, Fla., Dec. 21 (AP)-A circuit judge has sentenced St. Petersburg Times reporter Lucy Ware Morgan to a second jail term for refusing to name confidential news sources.

Judge Robert L. Williams sentenced Mrs. Morgan to 90 days in jail after finding her in contempt of court for refus-ing on Nov. 19 to identify sources to a Pasco County grand jury.

grand jury. On Nov. 1, Williams sen-tenced Mrs. Morgan to five months in jail when she re-fused to reveal her sources under subpoena from State Attorney James T. Russell. Mrs. Morgan quoted sources in a story that speculated on the contents of a sealed grand jury report, saying the report criticized Dade City officials.

criticized Dade City officials.

In a court affidavit, Mrs. Morgan listed Russell as the source of statements that the source of statements that the grand jury did not indict any-one and that the jury had looked into business transac-tions of Dade City Mayor Ed Starling and several commis-sioners, and into complaints about Dade City Police Chief Norris Nixon Norris Nixon.

Her article was published in the Nov. 1 issue of the Pasco Times, a regional supplement of the St. Petersburg Times. Mrs. Morgan, who will re-
