Mrs. Allende Tells of U.S. Travel Curbs

United Nations

The widow of Chilean President Salvadore Allende said yesterday she was prevented from visiting Washington at the invitation of ten American senators because of travel restrictions imposed by the U.S. government.

Hortensia Bussi de Allende, who Monday callled on the UN Human Rights Commission to condemn the military junta which overthrew her husband last September, arrived in New York from Mexico a week ago.

She told a press conference at U.N. headquarters that on landing at John F. Kennedy International Airport she was handed an unsigned document by the U.S. Immigration Service restricting her to a 25 mile radius of New York City.

Mrs. Affende called for a boycott of all trade and other links with the Chilean military government, and said it is an "extremely serious" matter that two warships are now being built in Philadelphia for the Chilean links.
