

Ford Reads News In Post, 9 Others

President Ford is "an avid newspaper reader," but also will make use of daily news summaries instituted by his predecessor, White House press secretary J. F. terHorst said yesterday.

Terhorst said one of Mr. Ford's favorite newspapers is The Washington Post, which former President Nixon long regarded as hostile to him, and he keeps close check on several other papers.

Among the other papers Mr. Ford was said to read or scan regularly are the New York Times, Washington Star-News, Los Angeles Times, The Wall Street Journal, The Baltimore Sun, the Detroit Free Press, the Detroit News, The Christian Science Monitor and the Grand Rapids Press.
