Dear

This letter concerns reports received by this office that you have committed an offense against the United States on or about ________ in violation of Section 12 of the Military Selective Service Act.

In accord with the President's policy of granting leniency to certain individuals who are charged with vio-lating Section 12 of the Military Selective Service Act, you are eligible for diversion to an alternate service program. Should you agree to undertake acceptable alternate service as an acknowledgement of your allegiance to the United States this office will refrain from prosecution. Note, however, that if no agreement is reached the United States will be free to prosecute you for the Section 12 charge. If the Director of Selective Service certifies to us that you have successfully completed your service, the pending charge against you will be dropped. However, failure satisfactorily to complete the alternate service will probably cause us to resume prosecution of the Section 12 charge.

A decision to seek acceptance into this program is one that must ultimately be made by you. Nevertheless, it is important that you immediately discuss this matter with your attorney inasmuch as your participation in this program will require a waiver of certain rights afforded to you by the Constitution. For example, you must waive your right to a speedy trial and right to have an indictment presented to the grand jury, if one has not already been obtained, within the prescribed statute of limitations. We suggest that you consult with your attorney who will explain the program to you and the nature of the waivers mentioned above.
