60% in Poll Give Ford

Low Performance Rate

Sixty per cent of the American people continue to give President Ford a low rating on the job he is doing, the Harris survey reported yesterday, according to the Associated Press. The percentage is the same as January's.

In questioning a cross section of 1,536 adults, the poll reported that 67 per cent opposed Mr. Ford's economic program, and 83 per cent doubted his antirecession program would do the job.

A similar 83 per cent said they had no confidence in the President's ability to stem inflation, and 80 per cent said they did not believe he was keeping the economy healthy. Last September, 54 per cent gave him a low rating on the economy's health.

The Harris organization reported that 54 per cent of those polled agree with the charge by Democrats that "he doesn't really care what happens to the unemployed."
