Greek Businessman Joins Ford Camp As Fund-Raiser

Washington, Dec. 8 (UPI) -
Thomas Pappas, who holds dual United
States and Greek citizenship, has been
investigated by the Senate and House
Select committees on intelligence for
alleged involvement in contributions from
Greek military dictators to the 1968 and
1972 Presidential zwzwyzi campaigns of
Richard M. Nixon andSpiro T. Agnew.

A House committee investigator said, "We couldn't pin anything on Pappas. But he was in the background."

Presidential transcripts made public in connection with the Senate Watergate investigation indicated that Mr. Pappas was the first man Mr. Nixon [Ehrlichman and Mitchell] thought of contacting to raise the hush money demanded by E. Howard Hunt....

And there have been reports that the [CIA] contributed to the Wixon-Agnew (over

campaign by sending money to the dictatorship's intelligence service, KYP, which then gave it to Mr. Pappas. A House investigator said the agency denied the allegations.
