NEW ORLEAN, March 1 (AP)—District Attorney Jim Garrison arrested today Clay Shaw, retired director of the New Orleans International Trade Mart, and accused him of having taken part "in a conspiracy to assassinate President John F, Kennedy."
No immediate charge was filed. William Gurvich, the dis-trict attorney's chief investiga-tor, said Mr. Shaw, 54 years old, "will be charged with par-ticipating in a conspiracy to murder John F, Kennedy."
Mr. Shaw, who retired 18 months ago from the Trade Mart post, was an Army major during World War II. He ar rived at Mr. Garrison's office at 12:15 P.M., and the arrest was announced at 5:45 P.M.
