GARRISON 300

NEW ORLEANS, MARCH 8 (AP)-CLAY SHAW, ACCUSED OF PLOTTING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, HEADED FOR COURT TODAY IN AN EFFORT TO QUASH THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S CHARGES.

GUY JOHNSON, THE TRIAL LAWYER FOR SHAW, SAID MOTIONS WOULD BE FILED (AT 10:30 A.M. CST) IN THE COURT OF CRIMINAL DIST. JUDGE BERNARD BAGERT, WHO SCHEDULED A PRELIMINARY HEARING ON THE CASE MARCH 14.

"WE WILL FILE MOTIONS FOR PARTICULARS--THE NATURE OF THE CRIME, THE NAMES OF THE CO-CONSPIRATORS, THE NAME OF THE UNNAMED INFORMANT," JOHNSON SAID.

"AND WE'LL FILE A MOTION TO SUPPRESS THE SEARCH WARRNT AND A MOTION TO QUASH."

THUS FAR IN DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON'S PROBE OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION, SHAW--A PROMINENT BUSINESSMAN AND FORMER MANAGING DIRECTOR OF THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE MART--IS THE ONLY MAN ARRESTED.

ONE WEEK AGO TODAY SHAW WAS LED HANDCUFFED FROM GARRISON'S OFFICE TO BE BOOKED ON A CHARGE OF CONSPIRING TO MURDER PRESIDENT KENNEDY. FOUR OTHERS HAVE BEEN SUBPOENAED TO THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FOR QUESTIONING AND RELEASED. SEVERAL SAID THEY COULD NOT UNDERSTAND WHY THEY HAD BEEN SUBPOENAED BECAUSE THEY HAD APPEARED VOLUNTARILY AND ANSWERED QUESTIONS PREVIOUSLY. NO ONE IN GARRISON'S OFFICE WOULD EXPLAIN THE REASO FOR THE SUBPOENAES.

GARRISON, REPORTED BY CLOSE ASSOCIATES TO HAVE BEEN OUT OF TOWN THE PAST SEVERAL DAYS, HAS VOWED THERE WILL BE ARRESTS AND CONVICTIONS RESULTING FROM HIS PROBE INTO A POSSIBLE NEW ORLEANS CONSPIRACY WHICH CULMINATED IN THE ASSASSINATION OF KENNEDY.

GARRISON ALLEGED IN AN APPLICATION FOR A WARRANT TO SEARCH SHAW'S HOME LAST WEEK THAT SHAW, LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND DAVID W. FERRIE MET AND DISCUSSED "HOW THEY WOULD KILL JOHN F. KENNEDY."

SHAW SAID HE DID NOT KNOW OSWALD, THE MAN IDENTIFIED BY THE WARREN COMMISSION AS KENNEDY'S ASSASSIN, OR FERRIE, A FREE-LANCE PILOT WHO DIED FEB. 22 WHILE UNDER INVESTIGATION BY GARRISON'S AGENTS.
