TARGETS FOR THE LATEST ATTEMPTS WERE WELLS OWNED BY TEXACO, INC. WORKMEN FOUND BOMBS BURIED NEAR WELLS IN THE MAURICE FILED NEAR THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNTY LINE AND IN THE GUEYDAN FIELD JUST NORTH OF THE GUEYDAN TOWNSHIP.

A CAREFUL CHECK OF ALL LOUISIANA OIL AND GAS INSTALLATIONS BEGAN AFTER WELLS OWNED BY SHELL OIL CO., AND CHEVRON OIL CO. WERE BYNAMITED SATURDAY NIGHT.

NEARLY TWO CASES OF DYNAMITE WERE FOUND LAST NIGHT IN THE CHALKLEY FIELD OF CAMERON PARISH ON LANDS LEASED BY SHELL.

THE TWO DAMAGED WELLS WERE BROUGHT UNDER CONTROL MONDAY.

SHERIFFS OF FIVE PARISHES TEAMED UP AFTER THE BLASTS IN A JOINT INVESTIGATION. AND EXPERTS FROM FT. POLK ARMY BASE PICKED UP THE UNEXPLODED BOMBS, WHICH REPORTEDLY HAVE IDENTIFICATION MARKS THAT WILL BE USED TO TRACE DOWN THE ORIGIN OF THE EXPLOSIVES.
