Shaw War Records Subpenaed

— A subpena has been issued, for the World War II military records of Clay L. Shaw, retired executive charged with conspiring to murder President Kennedy.

A spokesman for District Attorney Jim Garrison said the subpena was mailed to Washington yesterday to be served on the administrator of veterans' affairs.

Shaw was an Army major during the war.

The subpena commands William J. Driver, the administrator, to have the file on Shaw ready to be produced here in court April 24.

Garrison has accused Shaw, 54, of conspiring with Lee Harvey Oswald and David W. Ferrie in 1963 to kill the President. kill the President.
