'Prompting' Charge in JFK Plot

NEW ORLEANS — (UPI) — Attorneys for Clay Shaw asked a judge today to place Saturday Evening Post wtiter James Phelan under bond as a material witness, or allow them to take a sworn statement from him before Shaw's trial.

The attorneys said Phelan has agreed to testify that Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison's office "prodded" and "prompted" testimony from Perry Russo, a key witness against Shaw.

Russo testified at a preliminary hearing last month he heard Shaw, pilot David W. Ferrie and Lee Harvey Oswald plotting to murder President John F. Kennedy. Shaw subsequently was indicted by a grand jury on charges of conspiring to assassinate Kennedy.
