Garrison Links Ruby And Oswald

New Orleans

District Attorney Jim Garrison said yesterday that Jack Ruby's unpublished telephone number appears in code in address books belonging to Lee Harvey Oswald and Clay L. Shaw.

Garrison told Criminal District Court his investigation broke a telephone number code used by both Oswald and Shaw, a retired New Orleans executive accused of conspiring to murder President Kennedy.

The district attorney's disclosure runs counter to the Warren Commission report which found no indication of any link between Oswald and Ruby. Oswald was identified in the report as Kennedy's assassin.

Ruby shot and killed Oswald at the Dallas police station two days after Mr. Kennedy's death on November 22, 1963.
