NEW ORLEANS (AP)-DIST. JUDGE EDWARD HAGGERTY SIGNED SUBPONEAS THURSDAY DIRECTING A GROUP OF BUSINESSMEN FINANCING DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON'S ASSASSINATION PROBE TO PRODUCE ITS MEMBERSHIP AND FINANCIAL RECORDS IN COURT MONDAY.

THE JUDGE ALSO DIRECTED GARRISON TO TURN OVER TO THE COURT HIS RECORDS OF RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE PRIVATE GROUP KNOWN AS "TRUTH AND CONSEQUENCES."

THE SUBPOENAS HAD BEEN SOUGHT BY ATTORNEY FOR CLAY L. SHAW, WEALTHY RETIRED BUSINESS EXECUTIVE INDICATED ON A MURDER CONSPIRACY CHARGE IN CONNECTION WITH THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

TO DATE, THE NAMES OF ONLY A FEW OF THE MEMBERS OF TRUTH AND CONSEQUENCES HAVE BEEN REVEALED.

GARRISON HAS CHARGED A CONSPIRACY TO ASSASSINATE KENNEDY WAS HATCHED IN NEW ORLEANS AND THAT LEE HARVEY OSWALD, WHO THE WARREN COMMISSION SAID KILLED THE PRESIDENT, AND THE LATE JACK RUBY, WHO SHOT OSWALD TO DEATH, WERE PART OF THE PLOT.
