

CBS program on Warren Report. Criticism by Mark Lane
(some time later, no date; information through third party):

Marksmanship test. Weapon used cost \$150. Target, head
and shoulders area, three times larger than human
figure.

Eugene Crossman made first marksmanship test for CBS;
out of 18 shots, 8 hit the target; average time
6.5 seconds; CBS fired him, used 11 other marksmen,
who averaged 5.6 seconds.

Test of single-bullet theory. Gun was fired 20 feet from
target, instead of 180 feet.
