NEW ORLEANS (AP)--WILLIAM GURVICH, FORMER CHIEF AIDE TO DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON IN HIS KENNEDY ASSASSINATION PROBE, GOES BEFORE THE ORLEANS PARISH GRAND JURY TODAY PREPARED TO TESTIFY THAT THE INVESTIGATION IS A HOAX.

GURVICH, 42-YEAR-OLD PRIVATE DETECTIVE, QUIT JUNE 26 AS AN INVESTIGATOR WITH THE STATEMENT THAT THE PROBE SHOULD BE HALTED. HE SAID HE VOLUNGARILY UNDERWENT LIE DETECTOR TESTS IN CHICAGO TUESDAY TO BACK UP HIS CHARGE.

GARRISON HAS CONTENDED THAT A CONSPIRACY WAS HATCHED IN NEW ORLEANS TO KILL PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY. CLAY L. SHAW, 54-YEAR-OLD RETIRED BUSINESSMAN, WAS INDICTED MARCH 22 ON A CHARGE OF CONSPIRING IN SEPTEMBER 1963 WITH LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND FORMER AIRLINE PILOT DAVID W. FERRIE, BOTH NOW DEAD, TO KILL THE PRESIDENT. THE WARREN COMMISSION CONCLUDED THAT OSWALD ACTED ALONE IN THE NOV. 22, 1963, ASSASSINATION.

NEW ORLEANS (AP)--A CRIMINAL COURT JUDGE REFUSED TO SIGN AN INJUNCTION TODAY TO STOP DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON FROM SPEAKING ON A SCHEDULED NATIONAL TELECAST ABOUT THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION PLOT PROBE.

JUDGE EDWARD A. HAGGERTY JR., TOLD LAWYERS FOR ACCUSED ASSASSINATION CONSPIRATOR CLAY L. SHAW THAT HE HAD NOT ENJOINED ANYONE FROM DOING ANYTHING IN CONNECTION WITH THE CASE AND HE WOULDN'T DO IT NOW.

THE DEFENSE LAWYERS CLAIMED THE SCHEDULED TELEVISION APPEARANCE WOULD MAKE IT DIFFICULT TO OBTAIN UNBIASED JURORS FOR THE TRIAL OF SHAW ON CHARGES OF CONSPIRING TO MURDER PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

ASST. DIST ATTY. JAMES ALCOCK ARGUED FOR THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY THAT GUIDELINES ALREADY WERE IN EFFECT GOVERNING THE CASE, THAT GARRISON WAS AWARE OF THE GUIDELINES AND THAT HE SPOKE AT HIS OWN PERIL.

NEW ORLEANS (AP)--LAWYERS FOR ACCUSED ASSASSINATION CONSPIRATOR CLAY L. SHAW ASKED A CRIMINAL COURT JUDGE HERE TODAY FOR AN ORDER TO STOP DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON FROM APPEARING ON A NATIONAL TELECAST.

DEFENSE ATTORNEYS CLAIMED THE SCHEDULED TELEVISION APPEARANCE WOULD MAKE IT DIFFICULT TO OBTAIN UNBIASED JURORS FOR THE TRIAL OF SHAW ON CHARGES OF CONSPIRING TO MURDER PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

THE TELECAST, SCHEDULED AT 7 P.M. (CST) SATURDAY ON THE NATIONAL BROADCASTING CO. NETWORK, IS TO BE GARRISON'S REBUTTAL TO A RECENT NBC PROGRAM CRITICAL OF HIS PROBE.

JUDGE EDWARD A. HAGGERTY JR., WHO RECEIVED THE DEFENSE PETITION, PROMISED AN EARLY RULING.

MEANWHILE, WILLIAM GURVICH, FORMER CHIEF INVESTIGATOR TO GARRISON, WAS ORDERED TO APPEAR BEFORE THE ORLEANS PARISH GRAND JURY TODAY. HE WAS PREPARED TO TESTIFY THAT THE INVESTIGATION IS A HOAX.
