

Judge Refuses To Quash Shaw Indictment

New Orleans

District Judge Edward Haggerty Jr. yesterday refused to quash the assassination conspiracy indictment against Clay L. Shaw, the former director of the New Orleans International Trade mart.

Shaw was indicted last March on a charge of conspiring with Lee Harvey Oswald and the late David W. Ferrie to assassinate President John F. Kennedy in 1963. He has denied the charge and denied knowing either man.

The judge gave defense attorneys an additional week in which to file final pleadings, one of which might be a request to transfer the Shaw trial elsewhere.
