"San Francisco attorney Melvin Belli stopped in Hong Kong this morning long enough to hold a news conference, during which he plugged his new book and hung a string **max** unfavorable epithets on Americans currently in the news. And the kindest words he had for the President of the United States were "He's rough, tough and corny, but that may be what we need right now. Belli defended Jack Ruby, the man who murdered Lee Harvey Oswald, and he called the Warren Report on President Kennedy's assassination one hundred per cent correct. Belli put it this way: "There was only one murdered and that was Oswald. He was killed by Jack. Jim Garrison doesn't have a case." He of course referred to the New Orleans District Attorney who alleges there was a conspiracy to assassinate Kennedy....."
