

Delay Granted in JFK 'Plot' Case

NEW ORLEANS (AP) — Clay L. Shaw, neatly dressed in a dark blue suit, appeared in court yesterday and formally requested and received a delay in his trial on charges of conspiring to murder President John F. Kennedy.

Criminal Dist. Court Judge Edward A. Haggerty Jr. granted the continuance pending a decision on Shaw's request last week that his trial be moved at least 100 miles from New Orleans.
