### Garrison Charges Perjury To Former Oswald Friend

NEW ORLEANS, Feb. 21 (AP)—Kerry Thornley, a Marine Corps friend of Lee Harvey Oswald, was charged Wednesday with perjury before the Orleans Parish grand jury that is investigating the assassination of President Kennedy.

Mr. Thornley, 29 years old, of Tampa, Fla., was accused by District Attorney Jim Garrison of lying before the jury when he testified that he had not been with Oswald here in September of 1963.

Mr. Thornley, a free-lance writer, served in the Marines with Oswald at El Toro, Calif., during 1959.
