## New Move in Garrison Case

Attorneys for Clay L. Shaw, seeking to prove that barrage of publicity has pre-vented Shaw from getting a fair trial in New Orleans, called television and newspa-per officials to the stand yes-terday to provide records of their coverage of the case.

Shaw, accused by District Attorney Jim Garrison of conspiring to assassinate President John F. Kennedy, chain smoked as the newspaper clippings. television and radio tapes were put into the record.
