

Allen Dulles Subpoenaed By Garrison

A judge yesterday ordered former Central Intelligence Agency Director Allen Dulles to answer a subpoena in New Orleans March 28 and 29 in District Attorney Jim Garrison's investigation of the Kennedy assassination.

District Judge Matthew Braniff signed the order, which would grant Dulles immunity from prosecution, and instructed it be sent to his home in Washington.

Garrison subpoenaed Dulles on grounds he would be able to tell the New Orleans Parish Grand Jury whether Presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald was a CIA agent.

Garrison has contended that Mr. Kennedy was assassinated by a band of right wing adventurers with CIA ties, and that Oswald may not have been the assassin, but only a "pigeon" set up to take the blame.
